Twelve (12) months before the Big Day

Make appointments to visit <u>reception halls</u> and reserve.

Make appointments with local pastry shops to choose your wedding cake. Add a
regional touch to your cake and select local products: maple, cranberries, and
other berries.
Reserve your caterer; offer local cheeses - the region has more than five <u>cheese</u>
<u>factories</u> offering quality products.
Start thinking about your photographer and/or video maker and reserve early
because the wedding season is a busy one for them.
For a successful evening, consider reserving a DJ or musicians to provide

More	than six months before the Big Day
	Shop for a wedding dress and groom's outfit. Choose the wedding rings. Plan your honeymoon - you might find a peaceful hideaway right here in the region. Order your invitations. Meet with the manager of your chosen reception hall to plan the decorations. Reserve the necessary materials for the reception (decorations, sound system, lighting, etc.) Draw up your wedding gift list. Request unique regional products and quick romantic getaways that could enhance your first year together.
Four	months before the Big Day

Choose your hairdresser and make appointments. Create and order your thank-you cards. Select your music. Make an appointment with your notary regarding the marriage contract. Finalize preparations and reservations for your honeymoon.

One n	nonth before the Big Day
0	Visit your hairdresser and test a few hairstyles, as well as your make-up artist to test your make-up. Call your caterer and confirm the number of guests. Suggest a few ideas for lodgings (hotels, motels, B&Bs) to your out-of-town guests. Plan your seating arrangement. Hold your bachelorette and stag parties. Consider offering your guests a small thank-you gift.
