It means everyone can get back to enjoying their favourite winter sports—and maybe even trying some new ones, such as kicksledding or alpine touring. As the snow accumulates, illuminating the landscape, you'll find lots of ways to have fun with family and friends. So layer up and head outdoors to breathe in the fresh air and make the most of Centre-du-Québec's magnificent winter wonderland!

A great place to explore is **Parc régional de la rivière Gentilly** in Sainte-Marie-de-Blandford. Here you can enjoy fat biking, snowshoeing and Hok skiing (a hybrid sport combining cross-country skiing and snowshoeing). No need to load up the car with all your gear as there's a rental shop on-site year-round. For a complete experience, consider renting a cabin—a cozy sanctuary after an active day outdoors where you can warm up around a wood-burning stove. Feeling more adventurous? Pitch a tent on one of the 20 campsites and experience the blissful peace and quiet of nature in a different way.

At **Moulin Michel** in Bécancour you can combine culture and nature. There's a lovely snowshoe trail, accessible for free, bordering this charming historical site. Be sure to treat yourself to an "après-hike" snack at Café du Moulin, which serves delicious fresh pastries, savoury soups and tasty sandwiches. The on-site bar is open in winter, so you can enjoy a cocktail with friends after your visit or walk. Snowshoe rentals are also available, and snowmobilers are welcome.

December, be sure to visit the **Village illuminé Desjardins**. The magical atmosphere is guaranteed to put you in a Christmas mood! On the program: snowball fights, giant slides, a boot hockey rink, axe throwing, storytelling around a campfire, traditional dances and songs, and a horse-drawn carriage ride. Come enjoy some traditional Quebec holiday activities all in one colourful evening! Satisfy your sweet tooth with some treats, meet Santa in his cozy home, visit his toy workshop and stop by the one-of-a-kind elf school, where children can join in the activities.

For some quality outdoor time with friends or family, head to **Mont Arthabaska** in Victoriaville. With 15 km of cross-country ski trails and 10 km of snowshoe and walking trails, you'll have plenty of time to chat, laugh and unwind with your companions! If mountain biking is your thing in summer, try fat biking along the 10 km of snow-covered forest trails. Bringing the kids? Take them snow tubing in January and February. Top off your day with a hot chocolate or coffee at the Bistro-bar Le Mont, located at the summit, taking in some magnificent views of the town.


Winter also means skiing, of course, and there are two must-visit ski centres in Centre-du-Québec. **Mont Gleason** in the municipality of Tingwick features a rental shop, ski school, restaurant and bar. It also offers adaptive skiing for people with reduced mobility. The resort has everything you could want in a ski hill, offering a great experience for the whole family. The log cabin at the summit, complete with a central fireplace, is the perfect place to warm up between runs. Children will love snow tubing at the Super Zone LE TUBE! Or, for a change of pace, try alpine touring or hit the snowshoe trails. Every visit is packed with fun! The friendly atmosphere and outstanding snow conditions will keep you coming back time and again.

Another mountain you'll want to try is **Mont Apic** in Saint-Pierre-Baptiste. Here there are 14 trails, including five glades, two snow parks (one with a lift), a beginner slope with a magic carpet and two T-bars. Plus, the four snow tubing slopes are sure to please kids of all ages. Smiles and good times are all part of the package at Mont Apic. Gather around the outdoor fireplace or unwind in the chalet at the top of the mountain. Grab a bite at the main lodge before tackling the slopes again. Rental spaces for family gatherings and business events are also available.
